It must be within the law.

#### **To Note**

If other media parties apply to broadcast the same hearing, in certain circumstances you may be required to share the material, or parts of it, as stated in the Protocol.

#### What happens next?

The Broadcast Working group will review your application and decide whether to recommend your request, including any additional conditions, to the Lord President for approval.

If your application is refused, reasons will be provided. If the application is approved, you will be appointed a liaison officer. Permission may be withdrawn at any time in the interests of justice.
